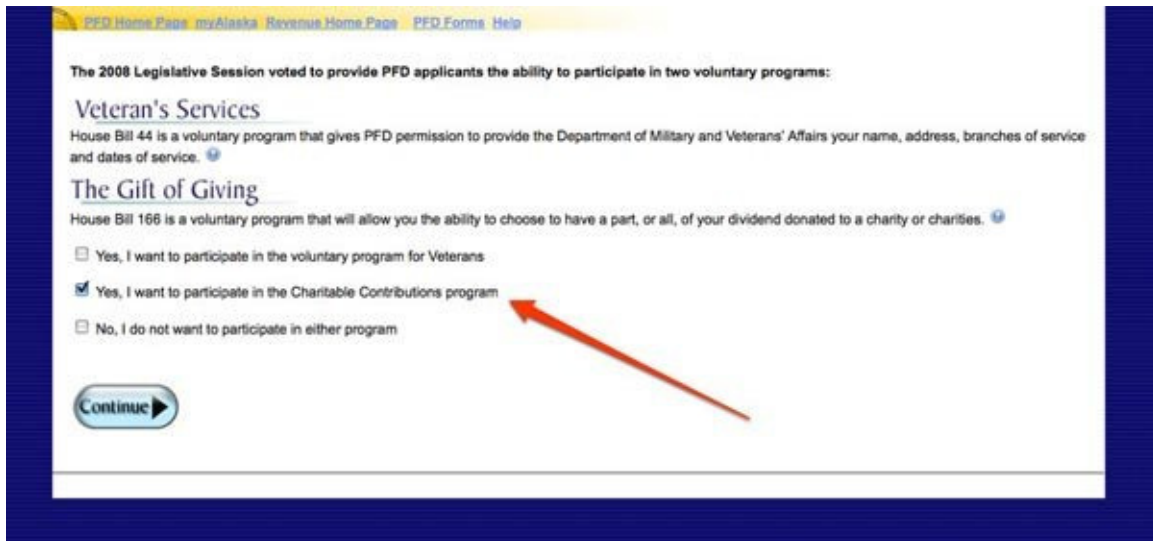


Pick.Click.Give.

STEP 1

After you have completed your regular PFD application form online, you will get the option to participate in two voluntary programs - Veteran's Services and The Gift of Giving. To give to Alaska Conservation Alliance and or several organizations of your choice, click on the box to the left of: "Yes, I want to participate in the Charitable Contributions Program"

STEP 3

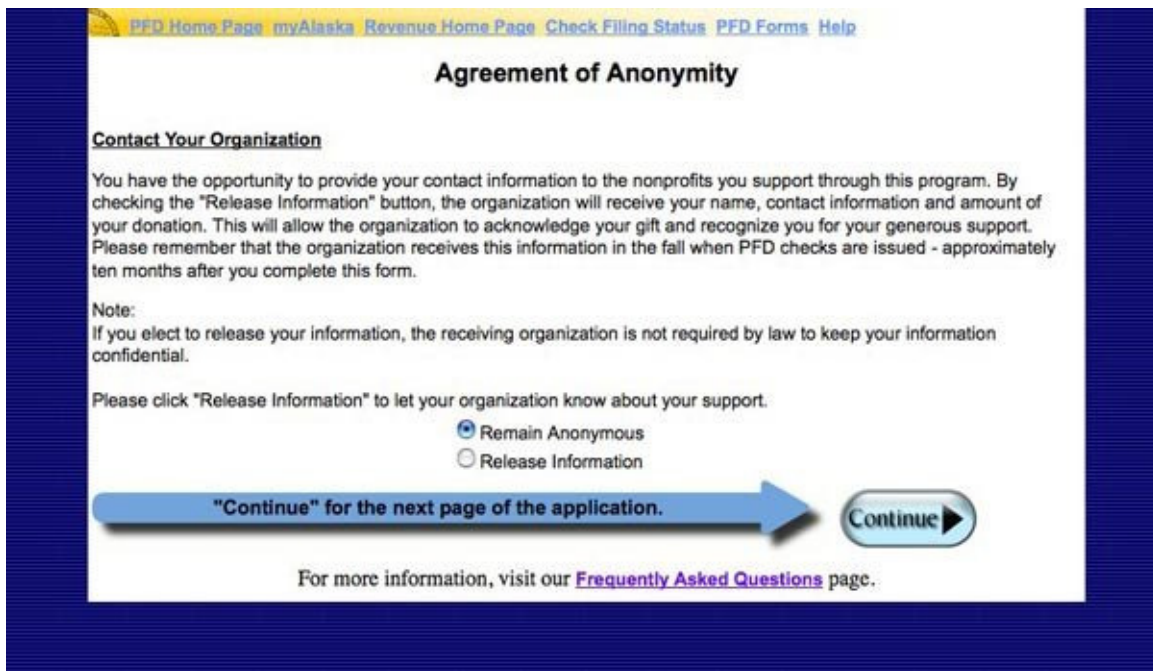
After you choose an organization and the amount you'd like to donate (in \$25.00 increments with the minimum being \$25.00), you can opt to add another organization or several organizations.

This will allow the organization to acknowledge your gift and recognize you for your generous support. Please remember that the organization receives this information in the fall when PFD checks are issued - approximately ten months after you complete this form.
